








- HIV is transmitted only through certain body fluids from a person who has HIV, who is not virally suppressed, and doesn't use any risk reduction measures.
- These fluids are blood, semen, preseminal fluids, rectal fluids, vaginal fluids, and breast milk.
- In the United States, HIV is transmitted mainly by having sex or sharing injection drug equipment, such as needles, with someone who has HIV.

- Achieve viral supression a low level of HIV in your blood
