Get in care.

If you don't have a doctor, Illinois HIV Care Connect can help you find one that you can see twice or more each year.

Stay in care.

By regularly seeing a doctor and taking your medications, you can achieve viral suppression — a low level of HIV in the blood.

Live well.

Once you achieve viral suppression, you are more likely to live a long and healthy life and less likely to pass HIV along to others.
